King's International Exchange Program offers opportunities to study abroad for one term (including summer terms) or a full year, earning credits towards your degree.

Program Details

- Pay regular tuition to King's, not international fees
- Bursaries and scholarships available
- Receive guidance from King's International staff
- Partner universities assist with accommodations, settling in, and any questions during your stay
- Remain eligible for OSAP while on exchange

Where Can I Go?

Choose from partner universities around the globe including: Australia, Japan, Switzerland, the United Kingdom, Brazil, the Netherlands, Spain, Germany, South Korea, and more.

Who Can Apply?

The following criteria (with some exceptions) applies:

- Students apply for exchange in second year and typically go on exchange in their third year.
- Students are selected based on academic achievement and sustainability as a King's ambassador.
- Successful candidates need a cumulative average of 70% or above.
- Programs are also open to international students. Students are required to study full-time while on exchange.

How to Apply

1. Attend an Exchange Information Session and search King's International Programs at kings.uwo.ca/international
2. Log into Atlas (<https://uwo-horizons.symplicity.com/>) using your UWO ID, complete one application with your top program choices, and submit by the deadline.
3. If successful, King's International will be in touch with you regarding next steps, including a mandatory Pre-Departure Session.
