Gospel: Mark 11:1-10

"When Jesus and his disciples were on their way to Jerusalem, they came near the Mount of Olives. Jesus said to two of his disciples, 'Go into the village straight ahead of you. As soon as you enter it, you will find a colt that is tied to a post. Untie it and bring it to me. If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing that?' say, 'The Lord needs it now, but he will bring it back to you.' So they went to the village and found the colt tied to a post near the house. When they untied it, some of the people said to them, 'Why are you untying that colt?' The disciples answered Just as Jesus had told them to, and the people let them take it. They brought it to Jesus and put their coats across its back. Jesus sat on the colt and rode into Jerusalem. Many people spread their coats and palm branches on the road in front of him. The people sang out: 'Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!'"

This is the Good News of the Lord.
