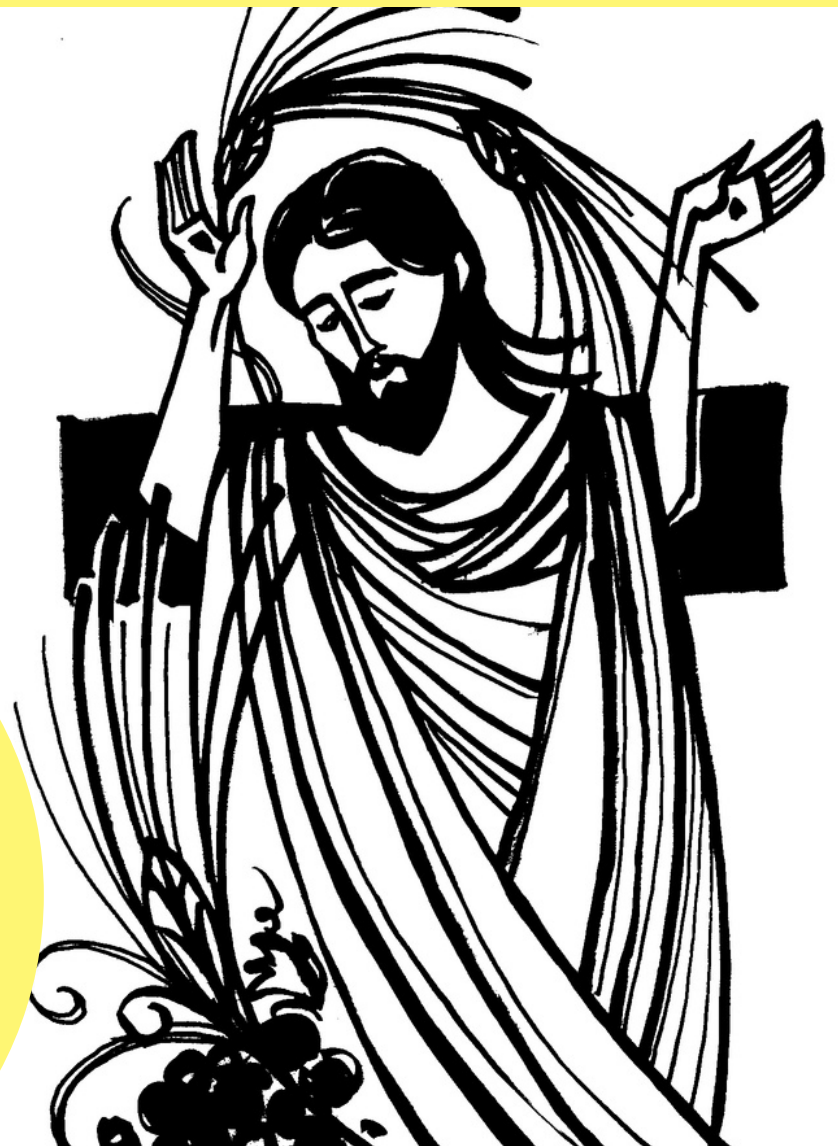

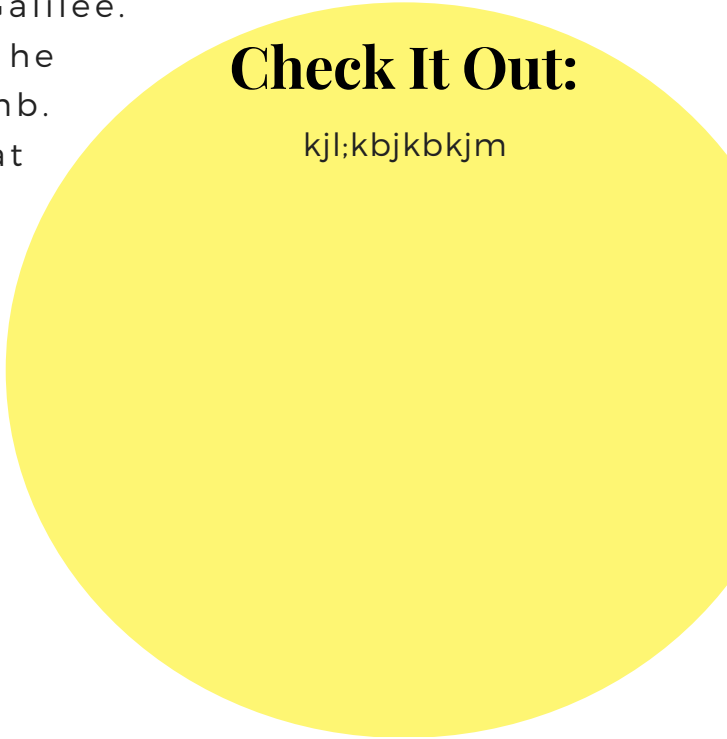


Gospel: Mark 16:1-8

"On the first day of the week, when the Sabbath was over, some of the women went to the tomb where Jesus was buried. The women's names were Mary Magdalene, Salome and Mary, the mother of James. They brought special oil with sweet spices in it to put on Jesus' body. It was very early in the morning, just after the sun had risen, and one of the women asked, 'who will roll away the huge stone from in front of the tomb for us?' But when they got there, they saw that the stone had already been moved. The women went into the tomb and they saw a young man sitting on the right side. He was wearing a white robe. The women were frightened. But the man said, 'Don't be afraid. You are looking for Jesus, the one who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here! Look, this is the place where he was buried. Now, go and tell his disciples, and Peter, that Jesus is going to Galilee. Say to them, 'You will see him there, just as he told you'' The women ran away from the tomb. But they did not tell anyone on the way what happened because they were afraid."

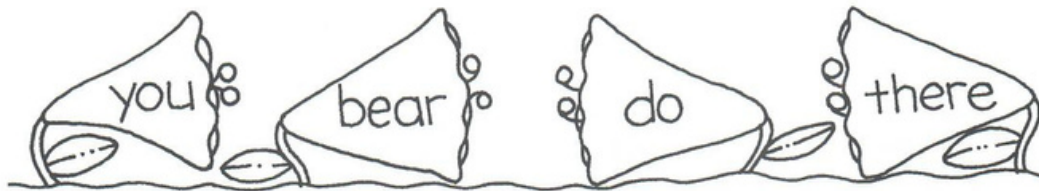
