# Chicago Style 17<sup>th</sup> Edition Checklist A resource created by Samiksha Sawant for The Write Place

#### Title page:

- Title should be center aligned, a third of the way down the page.
- Name, class information & date should follow after several lines.

### **General formatting:**

- Entire document is double spaced except block quotation, table titles, figure captions & bibliographic entries.
- Page numbers begin on the first page of the text, on the top right corner.
- Times New Roman/Courier font in size12
- Margins should be no less than 1 inch.
- Titles in text:
  - Italicized: long titles of books, periodicals, poems and plays.
  - Double quotations: short titles of articles, chapters and plays.

#### In text citations:

- Author-Date system in text
  - (Author, date)
- Notes-Bibliography system footnotes
  - Complete bibliographic citation

# **Bibliography/References:**

- Title is centered & without any effects (bold/italics/underline)
  - Page title 'Bibliography' for Notes-Bibliography system.
  - Page title 'References' for Author-Date system.
- Leave two lines between the page title and the first entry, and one line between every entry.
- Listed in alphabetical order
- Hanging indents for the first line of each citation
