English Proficiency: Students admitted to

King's University College must be proficient in written and

spoken English. We will require the following proficiency scores or higher, unless your agreement states differently:

- I.E.L.T.S. (International English Language Testing System) - 6.0 IELTS
- T.O.E.F.L. (Test of English as a Foreign Language) - Students must achieve a written TOEFL score of 550
- T.O.E.F.L. IBT - 80 and above (reading score of 15 and above, listening score of 16 and above and a writing score of 15 and above)
- Other standardized proficiency tests as discussed

When will the transcript be released?

- February 1 (for fall term students) / June 1 (for full year or winter term students)

## Exchange Information

### Health insurance:

All exchange students are required to purchase the University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP) at a fixed cost of approximately \$252 per term.

### Residence:

Exchange students arriving in September are guaranteed space at King's if they apply by the residence guarantee date. January arrivals must apply by November 15. Those who wish to stay in residence during the Christmas break must register by December 1. Additional fees of \$30 per day will apply (subject to change).

- Toronto Airport Arrival Fee - \$140
- Transcript Fee - \$50
