Develop the ability to analyze historical data, interpret sources, and engage with contemporary life through the exploration of past events.

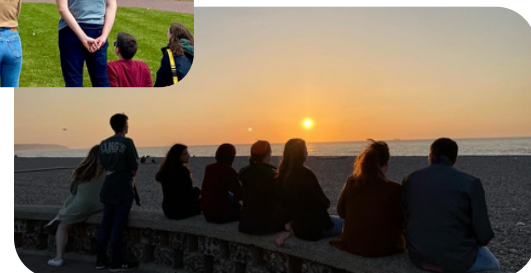
