- FR 2605/06: Reading Literature in French: Middle Ages to Romanticism/Modernity to Postmodernity.
- FR 2900: French Language, Advanced Level II (with a focus on grammar, vocabulary, and phonetics).
- FR 3900: French Language, Advanced Level III (with particular focus on writing skills).
- FR 4900: French Language, Advanced Level IV: Grammar and Use of French in the Workplace.
