First Year Courses:

In first year, full-time students pursuing a Global Commerce module typically take 3.0 principle courses and 2.0 electives:

- 1.0 course MOS 1021A/B and 1023A/B, or Business 1220E.
- 1.0 Economics 1021A/B and 1022A/B.
- 0.5 course from: Mathematics 1230A/B, Calculus 1000A/B
- 0.5 course from: Mathematics 1229A/B, Mathematics 1600A/B, Calculus 1301A/B, Calculus 1501A/B
- 2.0 additional courses: in any subject numbered 1000-1999 (MOS 1033A/B and Political Science 1022F/G are strongly recommended)

Career and Pathway Opportunities:

Graduates of our Global Commerce program are well-prepared for a variety of roles, including:
