First year Courses:

In first year, full-time students pursuing an Accounting module typically take 3.0 principal courses and 2.0 electives:

- 1.0 course: MOS 1021A/B and 1023A/B, or Business Administration 1220E
- 1.0 course: Economics 1021A/B and 1022A/B.
- 0.5 course from: Mathematics 1230A/B, Calculus 1000A/B
- 0.5 course from: Mathematics 1229A/B, Mathematics 1600A/B, Calculus 1301A/B, Calculus 1501A/B
- 2.0 additional courses in any subject numbered 1000-1999 (MOS 1033A/B is required by CPA)
