At King's, we prepare students for leadership roles in the fast-paced and ever-evolving world of finance and business administration. Interested in earning a designation after graduation? Our Finance and Administration program is affiliated with CFA (Chartered Financial Analyst) designation – a globally recognized professional designation in the finance world. Affiliation with the CFA means our Finance streams embed at least 70% of the CFA Program Candidate Body of Knowledge (CBOK) into our curriculum, including the Code of Ethics and Standards of Professional Conduct. Only King's and Ivey within the Western eco-system have this affiliation.

## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

### 1. MBA Style Orientation:

The King's BMOS program is one of the few business programs in Canada that offers an MBA Style Orientation. You will take core courses in all key business areas (marketing, operations, strategy and more) helping you become not only a finance expert, but also a well-rounded business graduate.

### 2. Quantitatively Robust Program:

All of our quantitative business streams (economics and math) are part of the business school at King's. This means you'll have access to a strong selection of courses focused on quantitative skills. If you have a passion for working with numbers and data, the Finance program at King's will be a perfect fit for you.

### 3. Hands-On Experience:

**Special Projects:** Almost every finance course at King's has a set of applied cases or projects. For example, every student must complete a Bloomberg Capital Markets certification and trading simulation in their Investment course.

**Beyond the Classroom:** Our student professional club, King's Capital Management, manages a real money fund sponsored by King's Alumni Association.

- 1.0 Business Administration 1220E or MOS 1021A/B and MOS 1023A/B
- 1.0 Economics 1021A/B and 1022A/B
- 0.5 from: Mathematics 1230A/B, Calculus 1000A/B.
- 0.5 from: Mathematics 1229A/B, Mathematics 1600A/B, Calculus 1301A/B, Calculus 1501A/B
- 2.0 \*\* additional courses in any subject numbered 1000-1999 (MOS 1033A/B is strongly recommended)
