

When God Became White with Grace Ji-Sun Kim at King's University College

London, ON – King's University College is hosting an engaging talk by Grace Ji-Sun Kim, author of *When God Became White*. The event will take place on Wednesday, October 2, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. in the Vitali Student Lounge, and online via webinar.

In her presentation, Grace will explore how the image of a white, male God emerged in Western Christianity, replacing the historical roots of Christianity in the ancient Near East. Her talk will highlight the profound impact of this distortion on Christian theology and its role in shaping colonialist attitudes globally.

Attendees will have the opportunity to participate in a Q&A session following the talk. The event is part of King's EDIDA Awareness Month, focusing on equity, diversity, inclusion, and decolonization.
