2	Would a 10 year contract be considered?
	Yes. Be sure to include why you feel a 10 year contract would be appropriate.
3	Is there a floor plan available for café 54?
	The best we have was provided in Addenda 5, file called "Library_King Centre Ground Floor Exiting Plan (4).pdf".
4	The RFP references "King's residence houses up to 400 students. Approximately 300
	residents are subject to a mandatory meal plan and 100 are offered voluntary meal
	plans." The 4 questions related to that are as follows
	(1.) Is your mandatory residence at capacity (300)?
	(2.) Exactly how many students are currently on the mandatory meal plan this year?
	(3.) How many on the mandatory plan last year?
	(4.) It may be too early however can you provide an estimate (based on your current
	knowledge) for mandatory plans for next year?
	We have approximately 245 on residence on meal plans this year much of impacted by lower
	international enrollments. We had close to 300 last year. I estimate will be about the same as
	this year, but could be higher depending on enrolment. Still early to say for certain. Note this
	gives opportunity to think about marketing meals and food beyond residence.
