# Important Dates and Deadlines

August 15 <sup>th</sup>	<ul> <li>⇒ 1<sup>st</sup> Installment of tuition and/or residence fees due. Friday, August 16<sup>th</sup> will be a grace day. Late fees will be charged starting Monday, August 19<sup>th</sup>. If you are an OSAP student, please ensure all your required documentation has been uploaded.</li> <li>⇒ O-Week opt-out DEADLINE for Full-Time, First Year students</li> </ul>
August 23 <sup>rd</sup>	$\Rightarrow$ International Work Experience (IWE) Program application opens.
September 23 <sup>rd</sup>	<ul> <li>⇒ USC Health and Dental Plan opt-out DEADLINE by 11:30pm</li> <li>⇒ Student Endowment fee opt-out DEADLINE by 11:30pm</li> <li>⇒ My Virtual Doctor opt-out DEADLINE by 11:30pm</li> <li>⇒ IWE Program application DEADLINE</li> </ul>
September 30 <sup>th</sup>	⇒ Scholarship and Bursary application <b>deadline</b> for most in-program awards at King's

# Student Statements

If you are enrolled in courses, your personalized fee statement will be available on the <u>SFS Portal</u>. Please log in using your UWO username and password.

If you recently changed your courses or made payment to your account, it may take 1-2 weeks to view an updated statement. You can view our <u>Fee Schedules</u> to know the amount to pay by August 15<sup>th</sup>.

Note: If you have successfully opted out of any of the above fees, it will not appear on your statement until late October.

# Payment Methods

King's offers students the option to pay their fees online or in-person. You can find our <u>Payment Methods</u> on our Money Matters page with instructions on how to pay your fees.

### OSAP Reminder (Ontario Government Student Loan System for Domestic Students)

The 2024/25 OSAP application is now available to submit online.

Students who intend on using OSAP funds to pay their fees should have completed their online application by June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024 and had all supporting documentation submitted by July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024. *Applications can still be accepted after these dates, but processing times can range from 4-6 weeks so your OSAP funding may be delayed. Late fees may apply to late applications.* 

Hints when applying for full-time funding:

- $\Rightarrow$  You will be asked for your OAN (Ontario Access Number) and password when logging in. If you have forgotten your OAN/password, you can either:
  - Visit the <u>OSAP website</u> for assistance, OR
  - Visit Student Finance at King's (or any post-secondary institution that administers OSAP) with your SIN card/paper and valid government photo I.D.
- $\Rightarrow\,$  Select Western University Canada as your institution and select a King's program from the existing list
