

Gospel: Luke 9:28-36

"One day Jesus took Peter, James and John and went up on a mountain to pray. While Jesus was praying, his face changed and his clothes became shining white. Then Moses and Elijah were there with Jesus and they too were shining in glory. They were talking with Jesus about how he was going to die in Jerusalem. Peter, James and John had fallen asleep. 
What Do You Think?

Calling All Saints: St. Joseph

On March 19, we celebrate Saint Joseph, the foster father of Jesus. God is the true father of Jesus but Jesus also needed an earthly father. Saint Joseph is the one who was entrusted to care for and raise Jesus while he was on earth. Joseph is also the husband of Mary and cared for her as well. God often communicated with Joseph through dreams. God told Joseph that Mary was pregnant with Jesus, God's son and Joseph also learned through a dream to leave Bethlehem after Jesus was born because King Herod was trying to come to hurt Jesus. Joseph was a "righteous man". He is not heard about much in the Bible until Jesus was lost and found again in the Temple so it is believed that he died before Jesus began his ministry. He is also the patron saint of the Universal Church, fathers and immigrants.
