

## 2026 Waste, Recycling and Compost Services RFP Addendum #3 re: Site Visit Additional Information

The below supplemental information was provided during the mandatory site visits.

### **P1-Wemple**

- Sometimes the cardboard bin is set too close to enclosure wall making it difficult to access the door. Solutions are welcomed.
- We might not need 5 bins for waste at this location.
- These waste bins are not always filled from front to back.
- The paper towel recycling bins are located in washrooms and kitchenettes, which results in less contamination.
- The painted hash marks in the parking lot are intended to keep access clear in the morning, but is not guaranteed. This is why we are asking for early morning pickup.
- This area is shared with our food service vendor.
- Racoons are a consistent issue in this garbage area.
- Our staff roll the bin out of the garage for you to pickup, then our staff rolls bin back into garage.

### **P5-Townhouses**

- Illegal dumping is an issue at this location.
- Considering removing the bins mid May to mid Aug, but in past this has resulted in ground garbage.
- When we have locked this bin in the past, it has resulted in ground garbage.

### **P3-SLC/Library**

- Illegal dumping is an issue at this location.
- Considering a bigger waste bin here.
- When we have locked this bin in the past, it has resulted in ground garbage.
- This is often the location for temporary bins (ie. yard waste, furniture, etc).
- Staff try to keep garbage/recycling on the same side of the street to spread it out.
- We try not to take up parking spaces with garbage bins in this lot.

### **P9-Commons Apartments**

- Waste bin is often not correctly placed. Wheels would help, but need to be lockable as ground isn't flat. We can consider improved placement of this bin, but we lease these buildings, so need to get approval from landlord for any changes.
- Would consider having recycling here, but does it fit along with garbage?

### **P7- STA**

- Illegal dumping is an issue at this location.

### **General**

- Our major pain points are education, contamination and illegal dumping.
- We discourage our employees from re-sorting garbage issues they see for ergonomic and capacity reasons.
- Lids are often left open in the winter due to snow build up causing lid to be too heavy to lift.
