### ► Improve Business Operations & Decision-Making (Management & Organizational Studies – MOS 3330)

Learn how businesses analyze, improve, and manage operations to increase efficiency and deliver value. Through simulations, case studies, and hands-on projects, you'll apply business theories in real-world scenarios, gaining skills that set you apart in the job market.

### ► Make a Real Impact on Youth Policy (Childhood & Youth Studies – CYS 3396F/G)

Work directly with children and youth in schools, advocacy groups, and community organizations while contributing to research on education and child welfare policies. Past students have helped shape Ontario child protection policies—your work could be next.

### ► Turn Social Justice into Action (Social Justice & Peace Studies – SJPS 3321F/G)

Get involved in housing access, climate justice, and Indigenous rights by working alongside organizations leading advocacy efforts. Gain firsthand experience in grassroots activism and policy change as you learn what it takes to turn awareness into action.

### ► Experience Politics Up Close (Politics & International Relations – POL 3366F/G)

Work on a real political campaign and see how elections operate from the inside. Engage with local politicians, strategists, and campaign teams to learn how policy is shaped, voters are mobilized, and governments are formed.

### ► Use Research to Drive Meaningful Change (Sociology – SOC 3358F/G)

Partner with local organizations to research real-world social challenges like mental health, food insecurity, and public policy. Gain experience in data collection and analysis that informs decisions and drives meaningful change in the community.

Travel, Learn & See the World

Studying abroad gives you the chance to engage with global issues, challenge your perspective, and learn how to be the change you want to see in the world.

### ➤ Experience Global Politics & Development Firsthand (POL 3367F/G)

Travel to Ghana or Ethiopia to see global governance, international development, and diplomacy in action. Meet political leaders, NGOs, and activists while visiting embassies, international organizations, and local communities. Gain firsthand insight into how policies shape lives—and how you can be part of the solution.

### ➤ Learn Diplomacy & Conflict Resolution in Italy (Social Justice & Peace Studies – SJPS 3211G)

Spend a month in Tuscany, Italy, living and learning alongside students from conflict zones worldwide. Explore reconciliation, diplomacy, and leadership in a program that challenges perspectives and equips you to drive meaningful change.

### ➤ Walk Through History Where It Happened (History – HIST 3710F/G & HIST 4710F/G)

### ➤ Study in Rome & Experience the Foundations of Christianity (Religious Studies – RS 2350F/G)
