### PATHWAY TO KING'S

Students graduating from **Lambton's Social Service Worker (SSW) diploma** with a minimum 3.5 GPA will be considered for admission to **Year 3 of King's Bachelor of Social Work (BSW)** program.

#### Why King's?

- **Graduate with a Western University degree**, from a university ranked among the **top 1% worldwide**

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

#### Admission Requirements

- Graduate from Lambton's SSW Diploma
- Complete the diploma within two years of applying to the BSW program
- Minimum cumulative **GPA of 3.5**
- No grade less than **"C" (2.0 GPA)**
- Letter of Endorsement from the Coordinator of the SSW Program
- Completion of complete **2.5 additional credits** (1.0 Science, 0.5 Research Methods – SOC 2206A/B or equivalent, 0.5 Arts/Humanities, and 0.5 elective) in the May–July term at King's with minimum 70%
- Completion of the **CASPer test** as part of the BSW admission process

#### College Entrance Scholarships

King's University College offers **unlimited Post-Secondary Transfer Entrance Scholarships** to qualified applicants.

Students must remain registered in 4.0 credits and meet King's residency requirements.

Final Average	Scholarship amount
80 - 84.9%	\$1,000
85 - 89.9%	\$1,500
90 - 94.9%	\$2,000
95% or above	\$2,500

#### Frequently Asked Questions

##### How many transfer credits will I receive?

**Transfer Credits:** Up to **7.5 credits** granted. Students complete **10.0** credits prior to entering Year 3.

Accept your Undergraduate offer of admission first. BSW offers be sent in August following summer course completion.

##### Can I apply to an alternate degree program?

Students are able to pursue degrees in other disciplines. The maximum credit granted to students applying from the SSW Diploma to other programs is 5.0 credits. For this path, students must achieve a minimum 3.0 CPA ("B") on their Diploma with no grade less than "C."



## HOW TO APPLY

### Follow all steps below:

#### Step 1: Apply to King's University College

Submit an undergraduate application through **King's Internal Undergraduate Application** with program code EKS by March 1. Note: If you are applying to another university in Ontario you must complete an OUAC application.

#### Step 2: Set Up Your Western Identity

Once your application is received, you will be provided with instructions to activate your Western Identity, which gives you access to King's Applicant Status Portal.

#### Step 3: Complete the BSW Application

Submit the online BSW application to the School of Social Work by **March 15** through the **King's Applicant Portal**. This link can also be found in your undergraduate application checklist.

\*\* If you already have your Western Identity set up from your undergraduate application use this to login to the BSW Application. Make sure you select the Bachelor of Social Work application from the drop-down list on the Application Management page.

#### Next Steps

1. Accept your Undergraduate Offer of Admission
2. Register for Summer Courses – Summer registration opens in March. Please contact [socialwork@kings.uwo.ca](mailto:socialwork@kings.uwo.ca)
3. Meet admissions conditions – Ensure you meet all conditions of your offer of admission
4. Submit all checklist requirements – Ensure you have submitted all checklist items including your final College Diploma by **June 1<sup>st</sup>**. Submit all documents through your application status portal.

#### Step 4: Log in to Your King's Applicant Portal

Using your Western Identity, log in to the **King's Status Portal** to:

- Check the status of your BSW application
- Confirm receipt of your references and **CASPer Test**
- Toggle between your BSW application and King's Undergraduate application
- View document checklists and application updates
- Confirm that all transcripts and required documents have been submitted. Final College Diploma **transcripts are due June 1<sup>st</sup>**.

#### Step 5 – Obtain a Letter of Endorsement
