King's **4-Year BMOS Honours Double Major in Sociology and Management or Criminology and Management** offers a unique interdisciplinary pathway that helps you understand people, organizations, and the social forces shaping today's world of work.

You'll gain practical skills in areas such as finance, marketing, strategy, and organizational behaviour, while developing a deeper understanding of social issues, institutions, and human behaviour through Sociology or Criminology.

Students typically begin in the Bachelor of Arts and Social Science in Year 1 and apply to the honours double major in Year 2. To qualify, you'll need a Grade 11 math course (mixed or university level), along with a strong GPA and successful completion of specific first-year courses (Grade 12 math is highly recommended). This pathway prepares you to meet the math and statistics requirements for the Management side of the program.

Whether you're preparing for a career in human resources, consulting, public policy, or community leadership, this program equips you with the analytical, leadership, and problem-solving skills employers value.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

1. Expand Your Career Opportunities

By combining Sociology or Criminology with Management, you gain a powerful mix of social insight and business expertise. This dual perspective opens doors to careers in both the public and private sectors, including government, nonprofit organizations, consulting, and corporate leadership.

2. Build In-Demand Skills Employers Want

Develop strong research, writing, and critical thinking skills through Sociology or Criminology, while gaining practical management knowledge in areas such as organizational behaviour, marketing, finance, and strategy. Graduates leave with the ability to analyze complex problems, communicate effectively, and lead diverse teams.

3. Follow Your Interests, Build Your Future

This double major gives you the flexibility to explore subjects you're passionate about—like Criminology or Sociology, while earning a management credential that sets you up for a wide range of career paths.

4. Accessible Entry, Clear Pathway

Students begin in the Faculty of Social Science in Year 1 and can apply to the double major in Year 2. A Grade 11 math course is required to meet the Management side's math and statistics requirements. (Grade 12 math is highly recommended). With the right course planning and academic support, students can confidently move into this interdisciplinary pathway.

5. A Unique Pathway

It is a unique opportunity to study two different subject areas as a formalized module combination within one degree. It is designed by King's faculty to help students succeed academically and professionally.

Sample Course Plan

Year 1 Courses:

Business 1220E or MOS 1021A/B + 1023A/B

Economics 1021A/B + 1022A/B

Math 1229A/B + Stats 1024A/B

((no grade 12 math required if math 1229A/B is taken prior to stats 1024A/B)

Sociology 1020

Elective (Writing, English, Psychology, etc.)

Year 2-4

You'll complete required and elective courses in both disciplines. In MOS, you'll study topics like accounting, organizational behaviour, marketing, finance, and strategic management. In Sociology or Criminology, you can explore engaging subjects such as:

- Sociology of Terrorism
- Sociology of Sport
- Race and Racism
- Drugs and Society
- Social Inequality
- Deviance and Social Control
- Police and Security

Additional electives include cross-disciplinary topics that link business and society, such as Organizational Behaviour, Project Management, and Corporate Governance.
